

Admission Instructions

- Eligibility: Bachelor's degree or above
- 10 Courses: 2 Foundation, 4 Core, 4 Concentration
- \$1560 per course (3 credits) in the English program. \$630 per course (3 credits) in the Chinese program.
- Frontline workers are eligible for scholarships. Students with financial difficulties and B+ grades can apply for scholarship support.

Academic Terms

There are three semesters each year: spring, summer, and fall (starting in early January, early May, and late August respectively).

The spring 2025 admission deadline is November 1, 2024. Admissions will be determined based on the order of complete application submissions and a competitive review process.
